 - Pastor Nick emphasizes that our mess-ups and lowest moments do not disqualify us from continuing in our faith race.
 - How does this understanding help you persevere in your faith during tough times?
- ▼ How can we ensure we are submitting to God's will rather than trying to fit God into our own desires?
 - Pastor Nick uses the example of Peter's expectations of a powerful Messiah conflicting with Jesus' true role of a suffering Savior.
 - Can you think of a time when you tried to fit God into your own desires? How did you learn to submit to His will?
- ▼ What does it mean to take up our cross and follow Jesus, as described in the sermon?
 - Pastor Nick references Dietrich Bonhoeffer's explanation of the need to abandon worldly attachments and surrender ourselves to Christ.
 - What does 'taking up your cross' look like in your daily life and how can you practice it?
- ▼ How can we experience the resurrection life that comes from surrendering and submitting to Christ?
 - Pastor Nick describes the resurrection life as one of hope, freedom, forgiveness, and purpose, united with Christ in His death and resurrection.
 - In which areas of your life do you need to surrender more fully to experience this resurrection life?
